Mumbai, April 23 (UNI): After the terrorist attack in J&K's Pahalgam, the state government is working in action mode for the safety of tourists from Maharashtra who have gone to that state and bring them back safely. According to the an official statement issued on Wednesday, Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar has directly contacted Chief Minister Omar Abdullah over the phone and requested him to provide immediate necessary assistance to tourists from Maharashtra.

Stating that the priority is to bring every tourist back home safely and provide relief to their families, special officers will be appointed in the disaster management room of the ministry to coordinate with the stranded tourists and provide them with necessary assistance.

Pawar has appealed to the grandchildren of tourists stranded in Kashmir not to panic.

# **Congress calls emergency CWC** meeting **Thursday over Pahalgam** terror attack

New Delhi, April 23 (UNI): The Congress party has called an emergency Congress Working Committee (CWC) meeting on Thursday at the AICC Office here in the wake of the deadly terrorist attack in Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir, that left 26 dead.

According to a statement issued by party general secretary KC Venugopal, the meeting will be held at 11 am at the 24, Akbar Road office.

Meanwhile, Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge in a statement on Wednesday said, "CWC shall meet tomorrow at 11 am in AICC Office, Delhi (24 Akbar Road) to discuss regarding the same. That is why I have preponed my programme, and I am leaving for Delhi".

Notably, the attack, which took place on Tuesday in the scenic Baisaran Valley near Pahalgam, left 25 tourists and one local resident dead.

### **Congress pays** tributes to Pahalgam terror attack victims

Mumbai, April 23 (UNI): The Maharashtra Congress observed a two-minute silence at the party headquarters here on Wednesday to pay tributes to the victims of the Pahalgam terror attack, followed by a march.

The march was held at Dadar in central Mumbai, strongly condemning the cowardly attack on innocent tourists in Pahalgam, Jammu and Kashmir.

Hundreds of Congress workers participated in this march and raised slogans against Pakistan and pro India.

Later, talking to media persons, Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) president Harshvardhan Sapkal said that this was a Pakistan-sponsored terrorist attack and demanded that terrorism be permanently eradicated by taking strict action against terrorists who carried out Pahalgam attack on tourists.

He further said that the government should convene an all-party meeting and take a unanimous decision on the Pahalgam attack to send a strong message that no such terrorist attack will be tolerated in future, he added.

Sapkal made an appeal that in this difficult time, all Indians should come together and condemn this attack.

New Delhi, April 23 (UNI) :A Delhi Court on Wednesday issued a non bailable warrant against Medha Patkar for infringing the court order by not furnishing the one-year probation bond and also not depositing the fine of Rs 1 lakh in a defamation case filed by Delhi Lieutenant Govenor Vinay Kumar Saxena.

Additional Sessions Judge (ASJ) Vishal Singh said, "Instead of appearing before the Court and to comply with the order on sentence dated 08/04/ 2025, the convict is absent and deliberately failed to comply with the order on sentence and to avail of the benefit of probation subject to furnishing of the compensation amount".

The court further said, "The intention of convict

It asked for report regarding the serving of the warrant on May 3, the next date of hearing.

# **Rejection of Mehul Choksi's bail plea** is major victory for Indian agencies

Mumbai, April 23 (UNI) : The rejection of the bail plea by a court in Belgium of absconding diamond merchant, Mehul Choksi, is a major victory for Indian agencies seeking to get him extradited, sources in the Mumbai Enforcement Directorate (ED) said on Wednesday.

ED is investigating the Rs 13,500 crore Punjab National Bank loan fraud case along with the Central Bureau of Investigation in which Choksi is figured as prime accused. CBI has filed six economic offences against him in 2018 and 2022. The sources also said that after a Court of Appeal

in city of Antwerp rejected Choksi's plea, the path to get him extradited to India is clear. According to the details, the Antwerp Court of Appeal on Tuesday rejected arrested Choksi's plea to release him on bail, saying that fears about him fleeing from the clutches of Belgian authorities are "legitimate".

Choksi was arrested in Belgium on India's request, but later he moved a bail application arguing that he is suffering from cancer and undergoing treatment while seeking liberty to be released on bail pending extradition proceedings.

His lawyer Vijay

Aggarwal had said that they will make an appeal against the rejection of bail.

It may be recalled that CBI had tracked Choksi in Belgium in July last year, after which an extradition request was sent on August 27, 2024. The agency even sent its team twice to convince the authorities to arrest him.

A second extradition request was sent by CBI shortly after August 2024 as Choksi was charged in six cases of fraud by the agency.

The extradition has been sought under Indian Penal Code (IPC) Sections 120B (criminal conspiracy),

201 (destruction of evidence), 409 (criminal breach of trust), 420 (cheating), (falsification of accounts) and sections 7 and 13 (bribery) of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

The Belgium government examined India's request at various levels and approved initiating action in the matter after it was convinced about the "dual criminality" clause in the 1901 extradition treaty between two countries.

An "order of arrest" for Choksi was issued by the Belgian prosecutors on November 25, 2024.

### **Tourists cancel Kashmir** plans after Pahalgam terror attack

Mumbai, April 23 (UNI) : The travel agents and tour operators in Maharashtra have started receiving cancellations for Kashmir bookings following the recent terror attack in Kashmir's Pahalgam.

Sameer Karnani, a travel agent and also an executive member of Travel Agents Association of India (TAAI), said Wednesday, "There is a lot of anger and frustration among the passengers. We have received too many calls in less than 24 hours of the attack from passengers rethinking and reconsidering their plans. There is also a rise in cancellations from inbound travellers.'

He also said that this will divert 90 percent of potential tourists shift to other destinations. The fear among people is also expected to affect Amarnath Yatra, which will start in July.

Mahesh Rajput, who operates a travel agency in Borivali suburb of city, said that Maharashtra is the biggest market for Kashmir tourism in terms of numbers and spending capacity but this terror attack has sparked worries among travellers from across the country, who were planning to visit the valley in near

He also said that Indians as well as foreign tourists have started inquiring about cancellations and rescheduling of their plans.

Vishvajeet Patil, president of Maharashtra Tour Organisers' Association, said, "People are scared after seeing the attack's visuals. Fear psychosis plays a huge role in such cancellations.

"We are asking people to wait for a while before cancelling their trips and are also getting them connected with people who are safely travelling in other parts of Kashmir," he further said. He added that the Association has decided that the agents will not cancel any tours on their own to send out a positive message for Kashmir's tourism industry.

Harsh Parekh, who had visited Kashmir several times, said that the attack has not only affected Kashmir's commercial tourism but also its religious tourism, specifically the Amarnath Yatra, which is supposed to start on July three and Pahalgam serves as one of the two routes to the Amarnath shrine and an attack at this crucial location has also sparked worries among the pilgrims.

### Jain community leader warns of state-wide agitation if demolished Jain temple not built at same site

Pune, April 23 (UNI): Jain spiritual leader Vinod Sankla-Jain on Wednesday threatened to launch a statewide agitation if 1008 Digamber Jain temple in Mumbai, demolished by the Brihanmumbai civic authorities, is not built by the Mahayuti government at the same site soon.

He has also written to Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis to register a criminal case against the official involved in demolition of old Jain temple.

He asked how the temple was demolished on April 16, before the high court could hear the appeal to stay demolition.

# Indian scientists develop optical sensing platform to detect cholesterol

A team of interdisciplinary researchers at the Institute of Advanced Study in Science and Technology (IASST) in Guwahati, an autonomous institute under the Department of Science and Technology (DST), has developed an optical sensing platform for cholesterol detection, based on silk fibre functionalised using phosphorene quantum dots.

A point-of-care (POC) device has been developed in the laboratory scale for detecting cholesterol using this, according to a Ministry of Science & amp; Technology statement.

It can sense cholesterol in trace amounts, even below the preferred range. It can be an efficient tool for routine monitoring of cholesterol levels in the human body.

The platform developed for cholesterol detection can help identify early symptoms of diseases like atherosclerosis, venous thrombosis, cardiovascular diseases, heart disease, myocardial infarction, hypertension, and cancer.

The project, led by Neelotpal Sen Sarma, a retired professor; Dr Asis Bala, an Associate Professor; and Nasrin Sultana, a DST INSPIRE Senior Research Fellow incorporated the material – the silk fibre -- into a cellulose nitrate membrane to create an electrical sensing platform for cholesterol detection.

The synthesised sensors were highly sensitive as well as selective for cholesterol detection. Furthermore, the electrical sensing platform generates no e-waste, a key advantage of the fabricated device.

Both sensing platforms respond similarly to real-world media such as human blood serum, experimental rat blood serum, and milk. The work has been published in the "Nanoscale" Journal, published by Royal Society of Chemistry.

Detecting fatal diseases at their earliest symptoms is essential, as abnormal biochemical markers may accompany sometimes disorders. Therefore, reliable point-ofcare (POC) detection of biomarkers associated with these diseases is necessary for personalized health monitoring.

Cholesterol is an essential lipid in humans, produced by the liver. It is the precursor for vitamin D, bile acids, and steroid hormones. Cholesterol is necessary for animal tissues, blood, and nerve cells, and it is transported by blood in mammals.

There are two types of cholesterol: LDL (low-density lipoprotein), often referred to as 'bad' cholesterol because it can accumulate in the walls of arteries and contribute to severe diseases, and HDL (high-density lipoprotein), known as 'good' cholesterol.

# 'Resign as minister or go to jail': SC to Senthil Balaji

New Delhi, April 23 (UNI): In a dramatic turn during the ongoing money laundering case tied to the 2011 cash-forjobs scam, the Supreme Court on Wednesday issued Tamil Nadu Minister V Senthil Balaji an ultimatum, either continue as a minister or retain the bail granted to him.A special bench, comprising Justices Abhay S Oka and Augustine George Masih, resumed hearing the Enforcement Directorate's challenge to Balaji's bail, which was granted in September 2024.

At the time of the bail order, the Court had taken into account that Balaji was no longer a minister, a factor central to its Article 21 analysis regarding prolonged incarceration.

However, with Balaji having resumed his

ministerial duties and now serving as the Minister for Electricity, Prohibition, and Excise, the Court expressed strong reservations.

"You are a minister! Look at the findings," the Bench observed, noting that categorical findings of settlements had been recorded against Balaji in earlier proceedings.

"We had granted bail on totally different grounds. If people are going to play with the process of law like this... we will record in our order that we made a mistake in ignoring the judgment findings against you," remarked Justice Oka.

Senior Advocate Mukul Rohatgi, appearing for Balaji, argued that the findings were not directly against his client and highlighted the ED's filing of a supplementary

complaint adding 21 accused and 34 witnesses.

Senior Advocate Kapil Sibal, also representing Balaji, suggested moving the trial outside the state, stating, "I'll never be able to influence anybody."

But the Court remained unmoved and said, "He had not been granted bail on merits. He had been granted bail on possible violation of Article 21," the Bench clarified. "What signal are we sending when you hold office of minister?"

In a firm but cautious stance, the Court did not cancel the bail but instead directed Balaji to make his choice clear at the next hearing scheduled for April 28."We'll give you a choice: post or freedom," the Bench declared, placing the political future and legal liberty of Senthil Balaji in stark contrast.

### Iran condemns fresh US sanctions amid indirect nuclear talks

Tehran, April 23 (UNI): Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesman Esmaeil Baghaei on Wednesday strongly condemned US's fresh sanctions on a number of individuals and entities linked with the Iranian energy, oil and gas sectors, as well as people involved in the country's "peaceful" nuclear programme.

Baghaei made the remarks in a statement released by the ministry one day after the United States issued the new sanctions targeting individuals and entities for their role in exporting Iran's liquefied petroleum gas and crude oil to foreign markets.

Baghaei said the US policy of imposing sanctions on the Iranian nation was a "clear indication of the American policymakers' hostile approach towards Iran's people and disregard for the rule of law and human rights."

"The US administrations' structural dependence on imposing economic sanctions on developing countries as a tool of intimidation and political pressure violates the fundamental principles and regulations of the United Nations Charter and international law," he added.

He noted that imposing sanctions on Iran's different economic and trade sectors was a "bullying and illegal" move, which is in explicit contradiction with the US claim of favouring dialogue and negotiations and indicative of Washington's lack of goodwill and seriousness in that regard.

The fresh US sanctions came despite the ongoing Oman-mediated indirect talks between Iran and the United States. The first round was held in Muscat on April 12, and the second in Rome on Saturday. The third round is scheduled to take place in Oman this coming Saturday.

### **US VP JD Vance says Russia-**Ukraine must reach a ceasefire or Washington will put out

Washington/Jaipur, April 23 (UNI): United States Vice President JD Vance has warned that Russia and Ukraine must reach a ceasefire agreement or the US will step down from its mediation efforts.

According to CBS News, addressing reporters during his visit to Jaipur, India, the US VP said: "We've issued a very explicit proposal to both the Russians and the Ukrainians, and it's time for them to either say yes, or for the United States to walk away from this

"It's now time, I think, to take, if not the final step, one of the final steps, which is, at a broad level, the party saying we're going to stop the killing, we're going to freeze the territorial lines at some level close to where they are today," Vance added.

"Now, of course, that means the Ukrainians and the Russians are both going to have to give up some of the territory they currently own."

Vance's remarks came as senior officials from the US, France, the UK, Germany and Ukraine were holding talks in London aimed at securing a ceasefire between Ukraine and Russia, after US Secretary of State Marco Rubio pulled out of higher-level talks that had been scheduled earlier.

Ending the Russia-Ukraine war has been one of the key agendas of the Trump administration, which had earlier said that it will end the ongoing threeyear-war in less than a week.

Despite President Trump's mediation efforts, no final solution has been reached by either party, as Kyiv has repeatedly refused to agree on Moscow's terms for bringing a ceasefire.

### WFP warns of rising hunger, malnutrition in Ethiopia

Addis Ababa, April 23 (UNI): The United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) has warned over rising hunger and malnutrition in Ethiopia as humanitarian needs outpace resources.

"Hunger and malnutrition are on the rise in Ethiopia as ongoing conflict, regional instability, displacement, drought and economic shocks leave millions without sufficient nutritious food," the WFP said in a statement issued Tuesday.

Noting that its life-saving response has been "severely hampered" by critical funding shortfalls, the WFP said some 3.6 million of the most vulnerable are at "imminent risk of losing food assistance."

According to the UN agency, over 10 million people are facing hunger and malnutrition across Ethiopia, including 3 million people forced from their homes due to conflict and extreme weather.

Malnutrition rates are alarmingly high, with 4.4 million pregnant, breastfeeding women and children in need of treatment, it said.

The WFP also warned that poor rainfall, which is anticipated in southeastern Ethiopia through May, risks another drought in the country's Somali Region as families are still reeling from the 2020-2023 drought.

Highlighting that humanitarian needs in Ethiopia are rising due to conflict in neighbouring countries, the WFP said it has supported 800,000 refugees in Ethiopia, including 100,000 Sudanese refugees, while escalating insecurity in northeastern South Sudan could drive 10,000 more refugees across the border.

The WFP said it has delivered food and nutrition assistance to more than 3 million people in the first quarter of 2025, including displaced and severely food-insecure Ethiopians and refugees.

It also expressed concern over access challenges, as ongoing violence and insecurity, mainly in the Amhara region, are disrupting humanitarian operations, threatening its ability to reach over half a million vulnerable people in the region.

### Four killed, 30,000 affected by flooding in

Somalia: UN

Mogadishu, April 23 (UNI): Four people, including three children, have been killed and nearly 30,000 others impacted by flash floods caused by moderate to heavy rains in Somalia over the last week, the United Nations relief agency has reported.

The UN Office for the Coordination Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) said two children and a woman died in the Iskushuban district of Bari region, while a 12-year-old girl lost her life in the Baidoa city of South West State.

"The rains, marking delayed start to the Gu (April to June) main rainy season, have been particularly heavy in Puntland and South West States. The infrastructure has been damaged and roads inundated," the OCHA said in an update released Tuesday in Mogadishu, the capital of Somalia.Local authorities in Puntland estimate that 4,500 families or 27,000 people have been affected in the Bari and Nugaal regions."Four lowlying settlements were inundated, affecting over 300 displaced families (900 people) and destroying shelters, water sources, and latrines," the OCHA said.

Moderate to heavy rains are forecast to hit Bay and Bakool, and parts of the Hiran region, with chances of flash floods in some areas. "Authorities are appealing for urgent assistance. Partners have initiated assessments to determine the impact and respond, despite very limited resources due to recent funding reductions," the UN agency added.

# **World Bank lowers Bangladesh** growth projection to **3.3pc in fiscal 2025**

The World Bank has lowered Bangladesh's economic growth projection to 3.3% in the current fiscal, down from its January forecast of 4.1 percent due to the political uncertainty and persistent financial challenges facing the country.

In its latest South Asia Development Update, the World Bank also warned the 12-month average inflation in the country could hit 10 percent in FY25.

"This primarily reflects the disruptions arising from last summer's social unrest and political tensions. It also reflects the trade disruptions, the persistence of inflation, worsening bank health, governance challenges, and general uncertainty about the country's political future, all of which will contribute to an expected decline in investment," it said.

The World Bank's growth outlook for the current fiscal year stands out as the gloomiest among other recent forecasts.

This comes a day after the International Monetary Fund predicted 3.76 percent growth of Bangladesh's gross domestic product for the current fiscal year, and the Asian Development Bank's projection of 3.9%, according to The Daily Star.In its South Asia Development Update released today, the WB attributed the overall deceleration in the first three quarters of FY25 to a sharp decline in private and public

Dhaka, April 23 (UNI): growth is likely to remain constrained through the rest of the year due to global trade disruptions, high input and borrowing costs, and continued domestic uncertainty, it added. This comes as Bangladesh is already in a massive economic turmoil, due to rising inflation, lack of private sector investments due to the security situations, slow manufacturing, and disruptions in the country's textile sector - its financial mainstay.

However, it has anticipated a recovery in the fiscal year 2025-26, although growth has been downgraded to 4.9 percent, reflecting lower investor confidence macroeconomic pressures.

The latest South Asia Development Update, Taxing Times, projects regional growth to slow to 5.8 percent in 2025—0.4 percentage points below October projections before ticking up to 6.1 percent in 2026. This outlook is subject to heightened risks, including from a highly uncertain global landscape, combined with domestic vulnerabilities including constrained fiscal space.

"Multiple shocks over

the past decade have left South Asian countries with limited buffers to withstand an increasingly challenging global environment," said Martin Raiser, World Bank Vice President for South Asia. "The region needs targeted reforms to strengthen economic resilience and unlock faster growth and job creation. shutdowns Now is the time to open to economic activity in the first agricultural sectors, and boost

### 2 Pak astronauts to receive spaceflight training in China

Beijing, April 23 (UNI): China will select and train two Pakistani astronauts for space missions, with one slated to serve as a payload specialist on a future Chinese space station flight, the China Manned Space Agency (CMSA) announced on Wednesday.

The selected Pakistani astronaut will conduct scientific experiments designed by Pakistan while performing regular crew responsibilities when in orbit, CMSA spokesperson Lin Xiqiang told a press conference in Jiuquan in northwest China. The selection process for Pakistani astronauts is underway following the signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement in late February, Lin said.

The selection involves a three-round procedure that includes a preliminary selection phase in Pakistan, and secondary and final selection phases in China, Lin said.Lin noted that China is currently engaged in discussions with other nations regarding potential foreign astronaut participation in the country's future space station missions.

# Vatican reveals Pope Francis' final words before his passing, said he was 'tired but content'

Rome, April 23 (UNI): The Vatican has revealed the final words of Pope Francis, who passed away on April 21. The 88-year-old spiritual leader of the Roman Catholic Church had reportedly said that he was both "tired" and at the same time "content", and thanked his longtime aide Massimiliano Strappetti.

Among his final words in the day before his death were, "thank you", according to the Vatican.

"Around an hour later, after making a gesture of farewell with his hand to his longtime health aide, Massimiliano Strappetti, lying in bed in his secondfloor apartment at the Casa Santa Marta, the Pope fell into a coma," the Vatican said."According to those who were with him in his final moments, he did not suffer. It all happened quickly," the church's statement continued, describing Francis' death as

"discreet ... almost sudden, without long suffering or public alarm". The Pope's health deteriorated quickly on Monday morning, according to the church, with "the first signs of the sudden illness" appearing about 5:30 a.m. local time.

During the Pontiff's final hours, he had hesitated to surprise a throng of 50,000 faithful who amassed in St. Peter's Square with a ride in the popemobile following his

Easter blessing from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican News reported. The pontiff had asked Strappetti, "Do you think I can manage it?"

Once Francis was reassured, he took his tour of the square, stopping to embrace people, especially children, on his route.

Strappetti was with the Pope on Easter Sunday when Francis blessed the throngs at St. Peter's Square.



# MI thrash SRH to climb to 3rd spot in IPL table

Hyderabad, April 23: Mumbai Indians produced a commanding all-round performance, led by pacer Trent Boult's incisive spell and a blistering batting display, to outclass Sunrisers Hyderabad by seven wickets in a onesided IPL clash at the Rajiv International Gandhi Stadium here Wednesday.

Chasing a modest target of 144, Mumbai gunned down the total in just 15.4 overs, courtesy of a blistering partnership between Will Jacks and Rohit Sharma, followed by fireworks from Suryakumar Yadav.

Jacks, who looked in sublime touch, got MI off the blocks, hammering two boundaries and a six. He perished for 22, caught Abhinav Manohar off Zeeshan Ansari, but not before giving MI the early momentum.

Thereafter, it was the Rohit show. The India skipper, building on his recent form, struck a fluent 70 off 46 balls (8x4, 3x6). He reached his second successive half-century Cummins and continued to toy with the bowlers.

A reverse-heave off Harshal Patel, a vintage pull off Jaydev Unadkat, and a majestic slog-sweep off Ansari typified the range of strokes on display.

Rohit eventually fell to Eshan Malinga, chipping a yorker-tailing delivery to Abhishek Sharma at midwicket, but by then the damage had been done. Suryakumar Yadav (40\* off 19 balls) took over, unfurling his trademark flicks, sweeps, and reverse cuts in a scintillating

He clubbed Malinga for a towering six over square leg and later dealt Ansari a pair of boundaries – the last of which was shelled at deep mid-wicket by Nitish Reddy, who complained of losing it in the lights. The dropped catch brought the match to a close, with Mumbai wrapping up the chase clinically in 15.4

Earlier, Trent Boult (4-0-28-4) was the standout performer with the ball, dismantling SRH's top and lower order after MI opted

with a wristy flick off Pat to bowl. His scalps included Travis Head (0), Abhishek Sharma (8), Abhinav Manohar (43), and SRH skipper Pat Cummins (1), the last two coming in a dramatic final over.

> Heinrich Klaasen (71 off 44) was the lone resistance SRH counterattacking with flair and power. He reverseswept Jasprit Bumrah for six and punished Hardik Pandya with audacious smashes, but his dismissal – caught at deep square by Tilak Varma - marked Bumrah's 300th T20 scalp and SRH's last genuine hope.Deepak Chahar (4-0-12-2) was miserly, rattling the SRH top order early, while Mitchell Santner bowled economically. SRH never recovered from their poor start, and despite a 99run stand between Klaasen and Abhinav, could only 143/8.Mumbai's clinical performance, fuelled by top-order brilliance and Boult's incisive spell, propelled them to third place on the points table, a remarkable turnaround after losing four of their first five matches this season and winning last four.

However, Bangladesh clawed their way back into the contest, thanks to Mehidy Hasan Miraz's five-wicket haul once again that turned the game in the hosts' favour.

Despite the pressure and a few nervy moments, Zimbabwe held their breath to edge past the finish line, sealing a thrilling threewicket win. It marked their first Test victory over Bangladesh in seven years and the first in over four years against any side for Zimbabwe.The two sides are set to face off again in Chattogram, with the second Test beginning on April 28.



### PM Modi let down people of Bihar : alleges

Patna, April 23 (UNI) :CPI (ML) on Wednesday alleged that Prime Minister Narendra Modi had let down people of Bihar by making a series of false promises one after the other, in the last 11 years of his tenure.

\\\\Senior CPI(ML) leader Dheerendra Jha said here that Modi had promised special package of Rs 1.25 lakh crores for Bihar during the assembly election held in 2015. Not a single penny was given to Bihar against special package, as promised by PM, he pointed out.

"Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has been demanding special status for the state since long but despite NDA remaining in power at the Centre and in Bihar, this genuine demand has not been fulfilled by Narendra Modi government so far", Jha

said, adding that for the sake of power, Kumar had forgotten to raise the special status demand with new vigour and strength.

Patna University, one of the oldest university in country was not granted the status of Central University by Narendra Modi government, he lamented.

"Makhana proposed by Narendra

Modi government will not serve any purpose in ameliorating conditions of farmers as those associated with Makhana are only 0.01 percent of total farmers of the state ", the CPI(ML) leader said and added that agro based industries like sugar mills and jute mills were closed since seventies, aggravating the condition of farmers in north Bihar particularly in Mithila

region.North Bihar had virtually no agro based industry and the areas had been frequently ravaged by floods which made the conditions of farmers pathetic, he added.

"Prime Minister should address the issues of public interests in Bihar during his rally in Madhubani on Thursday, rather than getting indulged in yet another political gimmick", Jha suggested.
