

The Court also directed the Registry to place the matter before Chief Justice K.R. Shriram for appropriate orders.Justice N. Anand Venkatesh issued the direction after observing that the Minister had prima facie misused the liberty granted to him by the Supreme Court which had stayed his conviction as well as sentence in a corruption case thereby allowing him to not only avoid the need for incarceration but also continue as a Minister.



Kashmir terror attack barbaric

Chennai, April 23 (UNI) Terming the terror attack against innocent tourists at Pahalgam in J and K as barbaric that shook the conscience, the Tamil Nadu Assembly mourned the death of 26 people killed in the attack and urged the Centre to take all steps to prevent recurrence of such incidents in future.

The CCS also decided to immediately close the Integrated Check Post at Attari and asked all Pakistani nationals in India to leave within 48 hours. Those Indians who have crossed over can return by May 1.Misri said no Pakistani national would be allowed to travel to India.

YSRCP demands probe into Rs 5,500 cr alleged scam Vijayawada, April 23 arrangement. (UNI) : Former Minister

Chelluboyina Srinivasa Venugopalakrishna on Wednesday accused Andhra Pradesh's Chandrababu Naidu government of "brazenly fostering a liquor mafia" while "orchestrating a campaign of false allegations" against the "transparent" liquor policy of the preceding YSRCP regime.

Speaking at a press conference in Rajamahendravaram, he lashed out against Naidu, charging him with shielding his "own history of corruption in the liquor trade" by "fabricating" cases against the YSRCP's governance.

There is a calculated effort by the coalition to divert public attention its "illicit from profiteering" through the liquor industry.

The leader pointed to a CID case from the YSRCP tenure that named Naidu as the third accused in a liquor scam, as he facilitated undue benefits for three distilleries through a quid pro quo

"Why is Naidu silent on this case?" they demanded, asserting that his administration's unchecked corruption caused a Rs. 5.500 crore loss to the state exchequer

between 2014 and 2019. The minister contrasted this with the YSRCP's transparent liquor policy, which eliminated private control over liquor shops, reduced their number by 33%, abolished 43,000 belt shops and 4,380 permit rooms, and imposed stricter regulations to curb illegal sales. These measures, they argued, prioritized public welfare over profiteering.

Under the coalition, however, the liquor trade has been handed over to a mafia controlled by its leaders. he said.

Calling for accountability, he urged the public to reject the coalition's diversionary tactics and demand answers on Naidu's role in the liquor scam. "The people of Andhra Pradesh deserve a government that serves them, not one that exploits them," he asserted.

STF Seizes 23 Kgs of Hashish Oil in ASR District; Three Arrested

Vijayawada, April 23: In a major crackdown on drug trafficking, the Special Task Force (STF) Central Team seized 23 kilograms of hashish oil in Maradapalli village under Pedabayalu mandal, within the limits of Paderu SHO. Preliminary investigation revealed that the contraband was being supplied from neighboring Odisha. A total of six individuals are believed to be involved in the smuggling network. Indian scientists develop optical sensing platform to detect cholesterol

A team of interdisciplinary researchers at the Institute of Advanced Study in Science and Technology (IASST) in Guwahati, an autonomous institute under the Department of Science and Technology (DST), has developed an optical sensing platform for cholesterol detection, based on silk fibre functionalised using phosphorene quantum dots.

A point-of-care (POC) device has been developed in the laboratory scale for detecting cholesterol using this, according to a Ministry of Science & amp; Technology statement.

It can sense cholesterol in trace amounts, even below the preferred range. It can be an efficient tool for routine monitoring of cholesterol levels in the human body.

The platform developed for cholesterol detection can help identify early symptoms of diseases like atherosclerosis, venous thrombosis, cardiovascular diseases, heart disease, myocardial infarction, hypertension, and cancer.

The project, led by Neelotpal Sen Sarma, a retired professor; Dr Asis Bala, an Associate Professor; and Nasrin Sultana, a DST INSPIRE Senior Research Fellow incorporated the material – the silk fibre -- into a cellulose nitrate membrane to create an electrical sensing platform for cholesterol detection.

The synthesised sensors were highly sensitive as well as selective for cholesterol detection. Furthermore, the electrical sensing platform generates no e-waste, a key advantage of the fabricated device. Both sensing platforms respond similarly to real-world media such as human blood serum, experimental rat blood serum, and milk. The work has been published in the "Nanoscale" Journal, published by Royal Society of Chemistry. Detecting fatal diseases at their earliest symptoms is essential, as abnormal biochemical markers may accompany sometimes such disorders. Therefore, reliable point-ofcare (POC) detection of biomarkers associated with these diseases is necessary for personalized health monitoring Cholesterol is an essential lipid in humans, produced by the liver. It is the precursor for vitamin D, bile acids, and steroid hormones. Cholesterol is necessary for animal tissues, blood, and nerve cells, and it is transported by blood in mammals. There are two types of cholesterol: LDL (low-density lipoprotein), often referred to as 'bad' cholesterol because it can accumulate in the walls of arteries and contribute to severe diseases, and HDL (high-density lipoprotein), known as 'good' cholesterol.

Iran condemns fresh US sanctions amid indirect nuclear talks

Tehran, April 23 (UNI) : Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesman Esmaeil Baghaei on Wednesday strongly condemned US's fresh sanctions on a number of individuals and entities linked with the Iranian energy, oil and gas sectors, as well as people involved in the country's "peaceful" nuclear programme.

Baghaei made the remarks in a statement released by the ministry one day after the United States issued the new sanctions targeting individuals and entities for their role in exporting Iran's liquefied petroleum gas and crude oil to foreign markets.

Baghaei said the US policy of imposing sanctions on the Iranian nation was a "clear indication of the American policymakers' hostile approach towards Iran's people and disregard for the rule of law and human rights."

"The US administrations' structural dependence on imposing economic sanctions on developing countries as a tool of intimidation and political pressure violates the fundamental principles and regulations of the United Nations Charter and international law," he added.

He noted that imposing sanctions on Iran's different economic and trade sectors was a "bullying and illegal" move, which is in explicit contradiction with the US claim of favouring dialogue and negotiations and indicative of Washington's lack of goodwill and seriousness in that regard.

The fresh US sanctions came despite the ongoing Oman-mediated indirect talks between Iran and the United States. The first round was held in Muscat on April 12, and the second in Rome on Saturday. The third round is scheduled to take place in Oman this coming Saturday.

US VP JD Vance says Russia-Ukraine must reach a ceasefire or Washington will put out

Washington/Jaipur, April 23 (UNI) : United States Vice President JD Vance has warned that Russia and Ukraine must reach a ceasefire agreement or the US will step down from its mediation efforts.

According to CBS News, addressing reporters during his visit to Jaipur, India, the US VP said: "We've issued a very explicit proposal to both the Russians and the Ukrainians, and it's time for them to either say yes, or for the United States to walk away from this process."

"It's now time, I think, to take, if not the final step, one of the final steps, which is, at a broad level, the party saying we're going to stop the killing, we're going to freeze the territorial lines at some level close to where they are today," Vance added.

"Now, of course, that means the Ukrainians and the Russians are both going to have to give up some of the territory they currently own."

Vance's remarks came as senior officials from the US, France, the UK, Germany and Ukraine were holding talks in London aimed at securing a ceasefire between Ukraine and Russia, after US Secretary of State Marco Rubio pulled out of higher-level talks that had been scheduled earlier.

Ending the Russia-Ukraine war has been one of the key agendas of the Trump administration, which had earlier said that it will end the ongoing threeyear-war in less than a week.

World Bank lowers Bangladesh growth projection to 3.3pc in fiscal 2025

Dhaka, April 23 (UNI) : The World Bank has lowered Bangladesh's economic growth projection to 3.3% in the current fiscal, down from its January forecast of 4.1 percent due to the political uncertainty and persistent financial challenges facing the country.

In its latest South Asia Development Update, the World Bank also warned the 12-month average inflation in the country could hit 10 percent in FY25.

"This primarily reflects the disruptions arising from last summer's social unrest and political tensions. It also reflects the trade disruptions, the persistence of inflation, worsening bank health, governance challenges, not decisions taken by and general uncertainty politicians. WFP warns of rising hunger, malnutrition in Ethiopia

Addis Ababa, April 23 (UNI): The United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) has warned over rising hunger and malnutrition in Ethiopia as humanitarian needs outpace resources.

"Hunger and malnutrition are on the rise in Ethiopia as ongoing conflict, regional instability, displacement, drought and economic shocks leave millions without sufficient nutritious food," the WFP said in a statement issued Tuesday.

Noting that its life-saving response has been "severely hampered" by critical funding shortfalls, the WFP said some 3.6 million of the most vulnerable are at "imminent risk of losing food assistance."

According to the UN agency, over 10 million people are facing hunger and malnutrition across Ethiopia, including 3 million people forced from their homes due to conflict and extreme weather.

Malnutrition rates are alarmingly high, with 4.4 million pregnant, breastfeeding women and children in need of treatment, it said.

The WFP also warned that poor rainfall, which is anticipated in southeastern Ethiopia through May, risks another drought in the country's Somali Region as families are still reeling from the 2020-2023 drought.

Highlighting that humanitarian needs in Ethiopia are rising due to conflict in neighbouring countries, the WFP said it has supported 800,000 refugees in Ethiopia, including 100,000 Sudanese refugees, while escalating insecurity in northeastern South Sudan could drive 10,000 more refugees across the border.

The WFP said it has delivered food and nutrition assistance to more than 3 million people in the first quarter of 2025, including displaced and severely food-insecure Ethiopians and refugees.

It also expressed concern over access challenges, as ongoing violence and insecurity, mainly in the Amhara region, are disrupting humanitarian operations, threatening its ability to reach over half a million vulnerable people in the region.

Beijing, April 23 (UNI): China will select and train two Pakistani astronauts for space missions, with one slated to serve as a payload specialist on a future Chinese space station flight, the China Manned Space Agency (CMSA) announced on Wednesday.

The selected Pakistani astronaut will conduct scientific experiments designed by Pakistan while performing regular crew responsibilities when in orbit, CMSA spokesperson Lin Xiqiang told a press conference in Jiuquan in northwest China. The selection process for Pakistani astronauts is underway following the signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement in late February, Lin said.

The selection involves a three-round procedure that includes a preliminary selection phase in Pakistan, and secondary and final selection phases in China, Lin said.Lin noted that China is currently engaged in discussions with other nations regarding potential foreign astronaut participation in the country's future space station missions.

Vatican reveals Pope Francis' final words before his passing, said he was 'tired but content'

Rome, April 23 (UNI): "Around an hour later, The Vatican has revealed the final words of Pope Francis, who passed away on April 21. The 88-year-old spiritual leader of the Roman Catholic Church had reportedly said that he was both "tired" and at the same time "content", and

after making a gesture of farewell with his hand to his longtime health aide, Massimiliano Strappetti, lying in bed in his secondfloor apartment at the Casa Santa Marta, the Pope fell into a coma," the Vatican said."According to those who were with him in his final moments, he did not suffer. It all happened quickly," the church's statement continued, describing Francis' death as

"discreet ... almost sudden, without long suffering or public alarm". The Pope's health deteriorated quickly on Monday morning, according to the church, with "the first signs of the sudden illness" appearing about 5:30 a.m. local time.

During the Pontiff's final hours, he had hesitated to surprise a throng of 50,000 faithful who amassed in St. Peter's Square with a ride in the popemobile following his

Easter blessing from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican News reported. The pontiff had asked Strappetti, "Do you think I can manage it?"

Once Francis was reassured, he took his tour of the square, stopping to embrace people, especially children, on his route.

Strappetti was with the Pope on Easter Sunday when Francis blessed the throngs at St. Peter's Square.
