Delhi court extends Tahawwur **Rana's NIA** custody by 12 days

New Delhi, April 28 (UNI) : A Delhi court on Monday extended 26/11 Mumbai attacks accused, Tahawwur Rana's National Investigation Agency (NIA) custody by 12 days.

Rana was recently extradited from the United States.NIA Special Judge, Chander Jit Singh, after hearing the plea on behalf of NIA through in-camera proceedings, passed an order, giving the central probe agency Rana's custody for 12 more days.

Rana, a Pakistani-born Canadian National, was brought before the Special Court after completion of his 18-day NIA custody.

The court had earlier dismissed Rana's application seeking permission to talk to his family members.Rana is one of the accused in the November 26, 2008, Mumbai terror attacks chargesheeted by the NIA in 2011 and by the Mumbai Police in 2023.NIA chargesheeted Rana for a larger conspiracy beyond 26/11 Mumbai attacks, whereas Mumbai Police chargesheeted him for his role in the 26/11 terror strike



SC slams Centre over delay in cashless treatment scheme for road accident victims

New Delhi, April 28 (UNI): The Supreme Court on Monday came down heavily on the Centre for the delay in implementing a cashless treatment scheme for motor accident victims, questioning the

facility for timely treatment. There is no scheme for golden hour treatment. What is the use of constructing so many highways?"

The golden hour, as defined under Section 2(12-

"You are constructing huge highways, but people are dying there because of lack of facilities," the Court observed.

A bench, comprising Justices Abhay S Oka and Ujjal Bhuyan, expressed displeasure that despite its January eight order, the Centre had neither complied with the directive nor sought an extension of time.

The Court noted that although Section 164A of the Motor Vehicles Act, which mandates interim relief to accident victims, came into force on April one, 2022, the government had not yet framed the necessary scheme.

Mahoba (UP), April 28 (UNI) : More than 50 people were taken ill after consuming stale food at a wedding ceremony in the Mahobakanth area of Mahoba district here in Uttar Pradesh on Monday, a police officer said here.Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Harshita Gangwar said that there was a marriage function in the Sataura village in Sandeep's family.

"Apart from his relatives, people from the village were also invited. It is being said that after the ceremony, the invitees suddenly started complaining of vomiting and diarrhoea." she said.

She said that the villagers were informed about the matter through the police dialling 112. "A team of the Health Department, along with doctors led by administrative officials, reached the spot and started treating the victims," she said. The DSP said that more than 50 people, including small children and women, have fallen ill in the incident. "They are being treated properly by a team of doctors. A team of doctors has also been called from Mahoba headquarters," she said.Kulpahad's Sub Divisional Magistrate Anurag Prasad is present at the spot and is constantly monitoring the situation. The doctors have said that the condition of all the victims is out of danger.

Woman killed for dowry in Pilibhit

Pilibhit (UP), April 28 (UNI): A woman was murdered allegedly for failing the dowry demand of her in-laws in Barkheda area of Pilibhit district here in Uttar Pradesh on Monday, police sources said here.

Police sources said that Deepmala, a resident of Bahadurpur village under Barkheda police station area, was married to Munendra, a resident of Chathiya village, in November 2023. "Deepmala's family has alleged that dowry was given as per the capacity in the marriage. Despite this, the in-laws used to harass Deepmala continuously when the additional demand of gold chain and car was not met," they said.

Police sources said that the family alleged that the inlaws first poisoned Deepmala and hanged her. "When her condition deteriorated, she was admitted to a private hospital in the city where she died during treatment," they said.

"Kazi" and "Sharia Courts" are not recognised under Indian Law, Rules SC

New Delhi, April 28 (UNI) : The Supreme Court on Monday reiterated that entities referred to as 'Courts of Kazi', 'Darul Kaja', 'Sharia Courts', or any similar bodies are not recognised under Indian law, and their decisions hold no legal enforceability.

A two-judge Bench comprising Justices Sudhanshu Dhulia and Ahsanuddin Amanullah recalled the 2014 precedent set in Vishwa Lochan Madan v Union of India, which had made it clear that Shariat courts and fatwas have no legal sanction.

The Court was hearing an appeal filed by a woman challenging the Allahabad High Court's affirmation of a Family Court decision that denied her maintenance. The Family Court had based its findings, in part, on a compromise agreement presented before a 'Court of Kazi'.

Writing for the Bench, Justice Amanullah remarked: "Bodies styled as 'Court of Kazi', 'Darul Kaja', or 'Sharia Court', whatever their label, have no legal standing. As previously held in Vishwa Lochan Madan, any order or directive issued by them is not binding, nor can it be enforced by coercive means. Such decisions may only have relevance if the parties voluntarily accept them, and even then, only insofar as they do not violate any existing law."In this case, the appellant-wife and the respondenthusband, both entering into their second marriage, tied the knot on September 24, 2002, following Islamic customs.

In 2005, the husband initiated divorce proceedings

before a 'Court of Kazi' in Bhopal, which were dismissed after a compromise was reached on November 22, 2005.

However, in 2008, the husband again filed for divorce before a 'Darul Kaja'. Around the same time, the wife approached the Family Court seeking maintenance under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

Later, in 2009, the husband formalized a talaqnama following the divorce granted by the 'Darul Kaja'.

The Family Court dismissed the wife's maintenance petition, concluding that she herself was the cause of the marital dispute and subsequent separation, and that the husband had not deserted her. The court also reasoned that, since this was a second marriage for both parties, there was no possibility of dowry demands.

The Supreme Court strongly disapproved of this logic, observing: "The assumption that second marriages automatically eliminate the risk of dowry demands is both speculative and without legal basis. Such reasoning has no place in judicial findings."The apex court also rejected the Family Court's reliance on the compromise deed. It found that the compromise recorded in 2005 contained no admission of fault by the appellant-wife. Instead, it merely reflected the parties' mutual decision to live together peacefully.Calling the Family Court's decision "unsustainable," the Supreme Court noted, "The dismissal of the appellant's claim was based on misinterpretation of the compromise, and lacks any solid foundation."

India reduced poverty levels with targeted welfare schemes, economic reforms

India has made substantial strides in reducing poverty levels with targeted welfare schemes, and economic reforms, according to the latest report by the World Bank.

In its Spring 2025 Poverty and Equity Brief, the World Bank acknowledged India's decisive fight against poverty. According to the report, India has lifted 171 million people out of extreme poverty.

"This achievement is a testament to the Government of India's commitment to inclusive development, focusing on both rural and urban areas. Through targeted welfare schemes, economic reforms, and increased access to essential services, India has made substantial strides in reducing poverty levels," the report said.

It noted a sharp reduction in extreme poverty in both rural and urban areas in the country.

While extreme poverty fell from 18.4 per cent in 2011-12 to 2.8 per cent in 2022-23 in rural areas, urban centres saw a reduction of extreme poverty from 10.7 per cent to 1.1 per cent over the same period.

The gap between rural and urban poverty shrunk from 7.7 percentage points to 1.7 percentage points, with an annual decline rate of 16 per cent between 2011-12 and 2022-23.

Notably, India also made strong gains in reducing poverty at the lower-middleincome level.

SC backs Allahabad HC's order in Shahi Idgah-Krishna Janmabhoomi case

New Delhi, April 28 (UNI) : The Supreme Court on Monday observed that the Allahabad High Court's order allowing the Hindu side to amend their plaint and add the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) as a party in the Shahi Idgah-Krishna Janmabhoomi dispute is prima facie correct. A Bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI) Sanjiv Khanna and Justice PV Sanjay Kumar made the remarks while hearing the appeal filed by the Muslim side challenging the High Court's decision.

"One thing is clear. The amendment to the original plaint by the Hindu plaintiffs has to be allowed," the Bench remarked during the proceedings.

The Hindu parties had approached the High Court seeking to amend their original suit by claiming that the disputed structure was a protected monument under the ASI and, therefore, the protection under the Places of Worship (Special Provisions) Act, 1991 would not apply.

Consequently, they argued, the structure cannot continue as a mosque. They also sought to make ASI a party to the suit, which the High Court permitted in March 2024. The Muslim side then approached the Supreme Court against this order.Earlier, on April 4, the apex court had issued notice to the Hindu side on this appeal.

When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the Court observed that the Muslim side's plea appeared "misconceived," with the Bench remarking, "This plea is absolutely wrong. The High Court should have allowed the amendment to add the parties to the suit."

The Court, however, granted time to the Muslim side to file their written statement and deferred further hearing.

In their plea before the High Court, the Hindu side asserted that a 1920 notification issued by the Lieutenant Governor of the United Province had declared the structure a protected monument under Section 3 of the Ancient Monument Preservation Act.

They argued that because of this historical status, the Places of Worship Act, 1991, which protects the status of religious places as they existed on August 15, 1947, would not apply. The Muslim side opposed the amendments, arguing that the Hindu plaintiffs were attempting to "wriggle out" of the bar imposed by the Places of Worship Act by introducing new claims."The proposed amendments show that the Plaintiffs are attempting to negate the defence taken by the defendant that the suit is barred by the Places of Worship Act, 1991," they argued.

The Allahabad High Court on March 5 allowed the amendment and the addition of ASI as a party, prompting the appeal before the Supreme Court. The original dispute traces back to a civil suit filed by the Hindu side claiming that the Shahi Idgah mosque was constructed on the Krishna Janmabhoomi land. The suit was filed on behalf of the deity Bhagwan Shri Krishna Virajman and some Hindu devotees seeking removal of the mosque.

Kattike Narsibai (55), a resident of Bonkuru village in Gadwal district, Telangana, suffered a sudden and severe headache on April 25 and collapsed at home. She was rushed to a nearby hospital, where she fell into a coma. For advanced treatment, she was later shifted to KIMS Hospital in Kurnool. After conducting

thorough examinations, doctors at KIMS diagnosed a critical hemorrhage on the right side of her brain. Despite their relentless efforts to save her, she was declared brain dead on Saturday.

Following this, Dr. Rambabu and his team from AP Jeevandan, along with donation organ coordinators at KIMS Hospital, sensitized Narsibai's family members about the significance of organ donation. With the wholehearted consent of her husband, son, and

other family members, her liver and both kidneys were donated, offering a second chance at life to three critically ill patients.Speaking on the occasion, her husband and son expressed pride in their decision. "Even though we have lost the pillar of our family, it brings us comfort and pride that she

continues to live on through others," they said emotionally. The donated organs were swiftly transported to

the recipients through a specially arranged Green Channel, with the cooperation of AP Jeevandan, Dr. Rambabu's team, and the Kurnool district police department.AP Jeevandan committee members appreciated the family's noble gesture, emphasizing that such acts of compassion have the power to transform lives and inspire communities.

United Nations, April 28 (UNI): Russia contributed \$2 million to the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR) last week, Russian Deputy Ambassador to the United Nations Maria Zabolotskaya said on Monday.

"Last week, Russia managed to allocate \$2 million to support the activities of UNHCR," Zabolotskaya said during a UN Security Council meeting on refugees.

Zabolotskaya also recalled that approximately 5 million Ukrainians have left for Russia after Ukraine started shelling Donbas residential areas. The diplomat also called for accountability for migrants deaths in the Mediterranean Sea, which she said has turned into a "mass grave."

The UNHCR was established in 1950 by the UN General Assembly to help people worldwide who lost their homes after World War II. It provides assistance to rebuild refugees' lives and is a strong advocate for rights protections.

31 civilians killed by paramilitary forces in Sudan's **Omdurman: Volunteer groups**

Khartoum, April 28 (UNI) : At least 31 civilians were killed by the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) in Omdurman, north of the Sudanese capital Khartoum, volunteer groups reported on Sunday.

"An RSF force carried out a horrific massacre, executing 31 people from the Al-Salha area, including underage children, in the deadliest documented mass killing the area has ever witnessed," the Sudanese Doctors Network, a volunteer group, said in a statement.

"We consider this mass execution a war crime and a crime against humanity. We call on the international community to act urgently to save the remaining civilians and to open safe corridors to allow them to leave Al-Salha, which is home to thousands of unarmed civilians," it added.

Meanwhile, the Central Resistance Committees of Al-Salha, another volunteer group, also reported the killing, saying that the militia abducted unarmed civilians from the area and executed them.

"Available data suggests that the number of civilians killed exceeds 30," the group noted.

The Emergency Lawyers Initiative, a third volunteer group, also condemned the killing, calling it "a brutal crime and a grave violation of all international conventions, amounting to war crimes and crimes against humanity."

Videos shared by soldiers wearing RSF uniforms showed detainees sitting on the ground before being shot. In the footage, one soldier was heard saying, "We will leave no prisoners anymore."

The RSF currently controls the Al-Salha area, situated in southern Omdurman, which has seen frequent clashes between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and the RSF. The RSF has not yet responded to the allegations.

Sudan has been mired in conflict between the SAF and RSF since mid-April 2023, a war that has resulted in tens of thousands of deaths, with the exact toll unknown.

Philippines raises alert on volcano southeast of

Manila

Manila, April 28 (UNI): Philippine authorities on Monday raised the alert level for Mount Bulusan after the volcano in Sorsogon province, southeast of Manila, spewed a dark plume 4.5 km into the sky.

The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology raised the alert level from zero to one on a scale of five, or from normal to low-level unrest, after a phreatic eruption occurred at 4:36 a.m. local time, which lasted 24 minutes.

"The event produced a bent plume that rose 4.5 km above the crater before drifting west to southwest," the institute said in an advisory, adding that ashes blanketed villages around the volcano.

The institute said the volcano produced "rumbling sounds" approximately 15 minutes before the eruption.

The institute warned of "chances of phreatic eruptions," urging villagers to be vigilant and prohibiting them from entering the 4 km danger zone of the volcano.

The institute also advised pilots and civil aviation authorities to avoid flying close to the volcano's summit.

There are 24 active volcanoes in the Philippines. Aside from Mount Bulusan, Mount Mayon in Albay province and Taal volcano near Manila are on alert level 1, while Mount Kanlaon is on alert level 3, or magmatic unrest, meaning there's an increased chance of a hazardous eruption, including explosive

43 Palestinians killed in Israeli attacks across Gaza: Civil Defence

Gaza, April 28 (UNI): At least 43 Palestinians were killed in Israeli attacks across the Gaza Strip, the enclave's Civil Defence said on Sunday.

Defence Civil spokesperson Mahmoud Basal told Xinhua that eight people, including three children and a woman, were killed when Israeli aircraft struck a tent housing displaced persons near Hamad City, northwest of Khan Younis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

In another attack, an Israeli airstrike killed five Palestinians and wounded several others, some seriously, in Deir-al-Balah in central Gaza, Basal added.

He also reported that six people were killed and 20 others injured in an Israeli airstrike on a cafe near the entrance to the Nuseirat

Lightning strikes kill 9 in Bangladesh

Dhaka, April 28 (UNI): A series of lightning strikes in parts of Bangladesh killed nine people on Monday, media reports said.

Four deaths were reported in different areas of Cumilla district, three in Kishorganj district and one each in Sunamganj and Netrokona districts from dawn until noon on Monday amid heavy rain.

The majority of the lightning fatalities occurred in rural areas where people were working on their farmlands, Xinhua news reported.

Death due to lightning strikes is common in the densely populated South Asian country during this time of a year, as the weather changes from the dry season to the rainy summer season. The Bangladeshi government in 2016 declared it as a national disaster.

A total of 297 people

including 242 men and 55 women died due to lightning strikes during the February-September period in 2024, Save the Society and Thunderstorm Awareness Forum (SSTF), a local organization, announced the death toll last October.

Experts claim that the surge in lightning strike deaths is attributable to climate change, which made the country more vulnerable to the impacts.

2 terrorists killed in SW Pakistan security operation

Islamabad, April 28 (UNI) : Two terrorists were killed during a security operation in Pakistan's southwest Balochistan province, the Counter-Terrorism Department (CTD) said on Monday.

The operation was conducted in Derakshan area of the provincial capital Quetta, a CTD official told Xinhua. An exchange of gunfire took place during the operation, in which one terrorist was shot dead by security forces, while the other detonated an explosive device, killing himself, the official said.

Following the encounter, CTD personnel recovered a suicide vest and a large cache of weapons from the scene.

The official said the terrorists were planning major attacks in the province, but swift and timely action by CTD forces foiled their plot.

Bessent says US may clinch first trade deal with India

Washington, April 28 (UNI) : One of the first US trade agreements may be with India, Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said on Monday.

"I would guess that India would be one of the first trade deals we would sign," Bessent told CNBC.

He recalled that US Vice President JD Vance visited India last week and talked about substantial progress in the talks.

Bessent also pointed out that the US has very good negotiations with other partners in Asia.

"I have mentioned that the negotiations with the Republic of Korea have gone very well, and I think we've had some very substantial negotiations with our Japanese allies," he added.

Vance said on Tuesday that the US and India had finalized the terms of reference for the trade negotiations, adding that very good progress had been made during his talks with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Vance also said that in February, US President Donald Trump and Modi announced plans to more than double bilateral trade to \$500 billion by the end of the decade.

Boat crash in **U.S. Florida** leaves 1 dead, 12 injured

New York, April 28 (UNI) : A private boat crashed into a ferry in the U.S. state of Florida on Sunday night, leaving one dead and 12 others injured.

The Clearwater Police Department confirmed the death of one person from the ferry, which had more than 40 people on board at the time of the collision.

"All of the injuries are from the ferry. The boat that struck the ferry fled the scene," said local police in a social media post.

The ferry came to rest on a sandbar just south of the Memorial Causeway bridge, and all patients and passengers have been evacuated, according to the post.The local fire department declared it a mass casualty incident due to the number of injuries, prompting multiple trauma alerts and the airlifting of two seriously injured individuals by helicopter.

The U.S. Coast Guard and Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission will handle the crash investigation, said the Clearwater Police Department.

The driver does have a significant history of interactions with police and with "health-care professionals related to mental health," Rai said.

"This is the darkest day in Vancouver's history," said Rai. The tragedy happened shortly after 8 p.m. (0300 GMT) near East 43rd Avenue and Fraser Street where the Lapu Lapu Day Block Party was going on.

Local media reported that a black SUV struck individuals who were either walking or waiting near food trucks, leaving multiple victims lying on the ground.

The suspect, a 30-year-old Vancouver man, was arrested at the scene. An investigation is ongoing.

Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney expressed his shock, saying in his social media account: "I am devastated to hear about the horrific events at the Lapu Lapu festival in Vancouver earlier this evening. We are monitoring the situation closely."Vancouver Mayor Ken Sim said: "I am shocked and deeply saddened by the horrific incident at today's Lapu Lapu Day event. We will work to provide more information as soon as we can."Named after a Filipino indigenous leader who fought against Spanish colonization in the 16th century, Lapu Lapu Day was officially recognized by the province of British Columbia in 2023 and is widely celebrated by the Filipino community in the province, where Vancouver is the largest city.

When it comes to locating plots, buildings, orienting homes, placing decor and even planning gardens the first thing which would come to our mind is unhindered flow of energy and a feel good factor. 
Do not opt for too many planters

and the DGP, but the Samajwadi people are neither going to be scared of the attack nor are they going to be scared of anyone's threats. Those who are threatening us or Ramji Lal Suman, they are not challenging us but the Chief Minister, DGP and those in uniform," he said.

The SP chief said, "They are flouting the law and order of the state. We are people who believe in law, the Constitution and democracy, those who are challenging us should come and talk with an open mind. Discuss openly. We are ready to talk with an open mind."

He alleged that some people in the BJP government have a free hand, they are openly flouting the law and order. "They do not fear the law because from top to bottom in power, people of their own caste are in power.

"As the crossexamination process could not be completed, the court of Special Judge has fixed May 17 as the next date of hearing," they said.

Sources said that Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader Vijay Mishra, a resident of Hanumanganj, had filed a defamation complaint against Rahul Gandhi in the MP/MLA court in the year 2018.

"He had alleged that Rahul made indecent remarks during the Karnataka elections in 2018 which hurt his sentiments," they said. Sources said that when

the Congress MP did not appear before the court, the then judge issued a warrant and summoned him in December 2023.

"After this Rahul surrendered in the court in February after which the special judge granted him bail on two sureties of Rs 25,000 each. After this, Rahul Gandhi was summoned by the court to record his statement," they said.Sources said that after several dates, Rahul reached the court on July 26, 2024 and recorded his statement. Claiming himself to be innocent, he said that a political conspiracy is being hatched against him. "After this, the plaintiff was directed to present evidence in the court," they said.
