SC agrees to early hearing of Surendra Gadling's bail plea in Bhima Koregaon **UAPA** case

New Delhi, Aug 8 (UNI): The Supreme Court today agreed to list for early hearing the bail plea of Dalit rights activist and advocate Surendra Gadling, arrested in July 2018 in connection with the Bhima Koregaon case under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) over alleged Maoist links.

Senior Advocate Grover, Anand representing Gadling, mentioned the matter before a Bench led by Chief Justice B.R. Gavai and Justices K. Vinod Chandran and N.V. Anjaria. He pointed out that the Special Leave Petition has been pending before the apex court since October 2023 and that Gadling has spent more than six years in custody."This has been adjourned 11 times. I have mentioned it six times. The registry is not listening; this is a very serious matter," Grover told the court, adding that a previous Bench headed by Justice Aniruddha Bose had already granted leave in the matter.

On being informed that the plea concerns bail, the CJI assured that the matter would be listed soon. Gadling has remained in jail since his arrest in July 2018.

Goods train derailment

Nashik, Aug 8 (UNI): Central Railway services toward Chalisgaon were suspended this morning after a goods train coach derailed near Nandgaon in Maharashtra's Nashik district. The disruption occurred when the freight train shifted from the main line to a loop line, causing one coach to jump the tracks.

A Central Railway spokesperson confirmed the incident halted all goods train movement and multiple passenger express services on this critical route. The Delhi-Mumbai Rajdhani Express was among trains temporarily stranded on the Manmad-Nandgaon-Chalisgaon section.

Railway repair teams from Nandgaon rushed to the site immediately after the alert and initiated restoration work. Officials emphasized no casualties occurred in derailment. Crews are currently working to clear track repositioning the derailed bogie.Normal operations will resume after completing necessary repairs and safety checks.

Rahul accuses Election to power

Bengaluru, Aug 8 (UNI) Congress leader Rahul Gandhi today launched a scathing attack on the BJP the Election Commission, alleging that Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government was "made through theft" and claiming that complete access to electoral data would prove that "seats across India were stolen."

"If we get this data, we will prove that not just one, but seats across India were stolen... Prime Minister Narendra Modi was made through theft," Gandhi told a public gathering in Karnataka, accusing the Election Commission of colluding with the ruling party to manipulate results.

He said the 2024 mandate rested on a margin of just 25 seats and that 25 constituencies were won with margins below 34,000 votes. "This is an attack on the foundational idea of the Constitution — one man, one vote," he said, warning that those responsible "will be caught one by one."

Citing his party's investigation into the Mahadevapura Assembly segment under Bengaluru Central Lok Sabha seat, Gandhi claimed that out of 6.5 lakh votes, 1.25 lakh were fraudulent. He alleged the irregularities took five forms

Cabinet approves Rs 30,000 cr compensation to OMCs for losses in domestic LPG

New Delhi, Aug 8 (UNI) The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi today approved compensation amounting to Rs 30,000 crore to the three Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (IOCL, BPCL and HPCL) for under-recoveries incurred on sale of domestic LPG. The distribution of the compensation within the OMCs will be done by the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas. The compensation will be paid in twelve tranches, an official statement said.

Domestic LPG Cylinders are supplied at regulated prices to consumers by the public sector Oil Marketing $companies\ namely, IOCL, BPCL, HPCL.$

The international prices of LPG remained at high levels during 2024-25 and continue to remain high. However, to insulate consumers from fluctuations in international LPG prices, the increase in cost was not passed on to consumers of domestic LPG which led to significant losses for the three OMCs.Despite the losses, the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies have ensured continuous supplies of domestic LPG in the country at affordable prices. This compensation will allow the OMCs to continue meeting their critical requirements such as crude and LPG procurement, servicing of debt, and sustaining their capital expenditure, thereby ensuring uninterrupted supply of LPG cylinders to households across the country.



Four police teams were dispatched towards Karnataka, and all exit routes from Maharashtra were sealed off. One team intercepted the vehicle, finding Sharanu Hande inside in a severely injured state.Police arrested Amit Suravase and his accomplices, and Hande was rushed to a hospital in Solapur. A case of kidnapping with intent to murder has been registered at MIDC police station, and further investigation is on, police said.

After 60 years, Police to have new structure: announces CM

The revamp includes the formation of new police station layouts as well as the establishment of dedicated Narcotics and Forensic Units.Fadnavis announced that the state government will extend full support to modernise the police force further.

Addressing a function organised at the Police Headquarters in Shivajinagar, Pune, Fadnavis also declared that the state has received proposals to establish five new police stations in the city and assured that approval would be granted. Additionally, the government is set to approve the recruitment of 1,000 personnel required for these new units.

The event marked the groundbreaking ceremony for various police infrastructure projects and

Fadnavis announced

that approval will soon be granted to appoint two additional Deputy Commissioners of Police (DCPs) for Pune. He emphasised that as cities continue to expand, it is essential to simultaneously enhance and reform the police force.In a step toward strengthening law and order, one new police station has inaugurated, and foundation stones have been laid for four more. This marks the first time the state government has sanctioned seven new police stations for a single city. Considering Pune's growing urban sprawl and industrial educational importance, bolstering the city's security has become a priority, he said.

Fadnavis highlighted developments surveillance in infrastructure. The first phase of Pune's citywide CCTV project was launched a decade ago. However, a modern command-andcontrol center was needed to complement the system with updated technology. Today, Pune has been the inauguration of new equipped with one of the capabilities, Fadnavis informed.

country's most advanced CCTV surveillance systems, integrated with artificial intelligence capabilities, he said. To enhance the safety of Pune city, advanced surveillance systems are being deployed, starting from the Bopdev Ghat area. BMC minibus bursts into flames

Mumbai, Aug 8 (UNI) A Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) minibus transporting civic staff burst into flames on the Eastern Express Highway near Panch Khadda in Kanjurmarg (East) during Friday morning rush hour.

The incident occurred at approximately 7:15 am while the vehicle was enroute from Bhandup Pumping Station to Bhandup Station.All occupants – the driver and three BMC employees – evacuated safely moments before the fire completely consumed the vehicle.Dramatic footage of

the fully engulfed bus circulated widely on social media platforms, showing traffic crawling past the inferno. Firefighters and police responded immediately, containing the blaze by 7:49 am. The minibus was completely gutted though no injuries were reported.Preliminary investigations suggest possible electrical or mechanical failure as the cause, with authorities launching a formal probe. While the incident caused temporary traffic disruption on the busy artery, normal flow resumed after the charred vehicle was towed away from the carriageway.

Four paws, one mission: Army's canine warriors brave landslides and floods to save lives near Harsil

As search and rescue teams from the Indian Army, NDRF, and SDRF work tirelessly after the devastating cloudburst near Harsil, a special group of heroes is quietly making a big impact: six fourlegged soldiers and their dedicated handlers.

These trained Search and Rescue (SAR) dogs from the Indian Army are navigating mud, rubble, and soaked ground to do what machines often cannot: find survivors.

Their names; Sara, Opana, Jansi, Hazel, June, and Rahi, may sound gentle, but their work is far away from being the same. Capable of detecting even the faintest scent of life beneath up to seven feet of debris, this pack is capable of scanning more than 5 acres in under an hour, matching the effort of 20 soldiers with high-tech gear.

Considering the current situation when seconds can mean the difference between life and death, their speed and accuracy are lifesaving.

Following the cloudburst on August 5 that ravaged the Dharali valley with landslides and flash floods, these canine soldiers were quickly flown in from Meerut, Dehradun, and Lucknow and deployed by the Indian Army's Central Command.

Sara, Opana, and Jansi had just completed SAR training at the Remount Veterinary Corps (RVC) Centre and College. Despite their youth, they are already experienced, having participated in earlier rescue efforts during the floods in Wayanad (Kerala) and Rampur (Himachal Pradesh).

June, one of the first responders, along with handler ADT Ghevarlal D Patel, had been in Harsil since May. As the rains poured and water levels rose, their rescue convoy narrowly avoided being swept away. Stranded but determined, they pressed on, ready to help.

As the disaster's extent became clear, more reinforcements arrived.

Dog Rahi was sent from Dehradun but faced blocked roads just 60 km short of Harsil. On August 7, when the weather permitted, Sara, Opana, Jansi, and Hazel were airlifted in, braving the dangerous conditions to join the mission.

At high altitudes, in relentless rain, and on unstable ground, these dogs have shown incredible courage, obedience, and stamina. With each successful rescue, whether of a trapped survivor or a missing loved one, they have brought not just results, but also hope and closure to grieving families."These dogs are not just trained, they're trusted," said an Army spokesperson. "They bring unmatched speed and accuracy to our operations. But more than that, their presence provides emotional support to both rescuers and survivors." From Wayanad to Rampur, and now Dharali, these canine heroes have shown time and time again why they are some of the Army's most valuable assets in times of crisis. In situations where machines fail and human hands cannot reach, these four-legged warriors continue their work, sniffing, searching, and saving lives.

Rare Pancreatic Condition in a 10-Year-Old Boy

Chronic Calcific Pancreatitis is a very rare condition in children, characterized by the formation of stones in the pancreas over a prolonged period. In South India, it is seen in only about 126 children per 1 lakh population just 0.126%.

A 10-year-old boy named Rithik, suffering from severe abdominal pain, fever, and other symptoms due to this rare condition, underwent a successful surgery at KIMS Hospital, Kurnool. The surgical team, led by Consultant Surgical Gastroenterologist Dr. S. J. Janakiram and Pediatric Surgeon Dr. M. Sreekanth Babu, performed the Frey's Procedure to relieve his condition."Rithik had been suffering from this problem since the age of five. It is a progressive disease that



gradually worsens over time, leading to the formation of numerous stones in the pancreas, especially in the head region. Normally, the pancreatic head is larger

than the body and tail portions. The pancreas plays a vital role in producing insulin and aiding digestion.In his case, the stones had been

years, causing repeated episodes of severe abdominal pain. His parents had been taking him to local hospitals for treatment. Eventually, doctors advised them to go to Hyderabad for further care. However, upon learning about the facilities at KIMS Hospital, Kurnool,

they brought him here. We first conducted an MRI to thoroughly assess his condition and decided that Frey's Procedure was the only effective surgical option. Since the patient was only 10 years old, we involved Pediatric Surgeon Dr. M. Sreekanth Babu. Together, we opened the pancreas, removed all the stones, and also excised some affected tissue. The stones had caused significant swelling in the pancreatic duct, which returned to normal size after stone removal. A small section of the intestine was also resected and then surgically joined to the pancreas. This surgery will completely relieve his abdominal pain. However, because the pancreas will

not function normally as before, there is a higher risk of developing diabetes in the future. He may also experience oil droplets in the stool (oil stools) after consuming fatty foods, for which we have prescribed medication. This is a chronic condition and cannot be fully cured, but removing the stones ensures that his pain will be completely eliminated. We have explained all these aspects and the necessary precautions to his parents," said Dr. Janakiram and Dr. Sreekanth Babu.

Such complex cases usually require treatment in major cities like Hyderabad or Bengaluru. Now, with multi-specialty expertise and advanced facilities available at KIMS Hospital, Kurnool, people in the Rayalaseema region can access this level of care locally.

Hostage families sail toward Gaza calling for Israel to end war

Jerusalem, Aug 8 (UNI): Families of some of the Israeli hostages still held in Gaza have sailed towards the Palestinian enclave, in a d?esperate attempt to put pressure on the government of Prime MinisterBenjamin Netanyahu as it contemplates expanding the war in Gaza.

The Hostages and Missing Families Forum, as well as the opposition and a large part of the Israeli public, are strongly against the expansion of the operation, arguing it would put their loved ones at even more risk, CNN reported. As the flotilla set off on Thursday from the port of Ashkelon in southern Israel, Lior Horev from the hostage families forum told CNN the sailing was "an SOS call". "Unfortunately, we cannot enter Gaza and get our loved ones back home, but...this is a mayday call to the Israeli government," he said.

Israel's security cabinet was convened on Thursday to vote on a full reoccupation of Gaza, a move that would mark a major escalation of the conflict after nearly two years of war in the territory. At least 61,158 Palestinians have been killed in Gaza since the war started after the Hamas-led October 7 terror attacks, the Ministry of Health there reported on Wednesday.

U.S. judge orders temporary halt to construction of "Alligator **Alcatraz**" detention center

Washington, Aug 8 (UNI): A U.S. federal judge on Thursday ordered Florida to temporarily halt construction at an immigration detention center in the Everglades, marking a temporary win for environmental advocates. The judge, Kathleen M. Williams at the U.S. District Court in the Southern District of Florida, issued a temporary restraining order, halting construction for two weeks while she considers the arguments.

In June, environmental organizations filed a lawsuit, claiming that the immigration detention facility was developed without conducting the environmental review mandated by federal law.

Florida's so-called "Alligator Alcatraz," a proposed immigration detention facility, has sparked significant controversies revolving around environmental concerns and poor conditions. The controversial project, which is run by the state but houses federal immigration detainees, came as part of the Trump administration's mass deportation plan against undocumented immigrants. Meanwhile, "Alligator Alcatraz" has faced other legal action for alleged inhumane conditions and treatment of detainees.

Teenager arrested after man critically injured in Sydney public park stabbing

Sydney, Aug 8 (UNI): A man has been hospitalized in a critical condition and a teenager has been arrested following the stabbing attack at a public park in Sydney.

Emergency services were called to reports of an assault at the park in the inner-western Sydney suburb of Annandale at about 10:45 p.m. on Thursday.

Police officers arrived and found six men with a range of injuries, who said they had been assaulted by a group of four unknown males following an argument.

One of the victims, a 21-year-old man, suffered stab wounds and was taken to hospital in a critical condition.

Four more of the injured men were also taken to hospital, while one was treated at the scene by ambulance paramedics but did not require hospitalization.

Police established a crime scene and commenced an investigation into the incident. Following inquiries. a 15-year-old boy was arrested in Annandale at around 12:15 a.m. and taken to a nearby police station.

Trump nominates Stephen Miran to chair Council of Economic Advisors

Washington, Aug 8 (UNI): US President Donald Trump announced Thursday he had chosen Stephen Miran, chair of the Council of Economic Advisors, to serve in the just vacated seat on the Federal Reserve Board until Jan. 31, 2026.

Meanwhile, the Trump administration will continue to search for a permanent replacement to the vacancy left by Fed Governor Adriana Kugler, whose resignation will be effective on Aug. 8.

Miran is seen as one of the key advisers in shaping U.S. trade policies in Trump's second term. He served as an adviser of economic policy for the U.S. Department of the Treasury from 2020 to 2021. The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System is designed to have seven members, who are nominated by the U.S. president and confirmed by the Senate.

Mexican President Sheinbaum slams anti-migrant raids in US

Mexico City, Aug 8 (UNI): Mexican President Claudia Sheinbaum has come down heavily on the latest anti-migrant raids in the United States, vowing to protect Mexican nationals staying in the US.

"We do not agree with the raids, and we will protect and help our compatriots," the Mexican president said at her daily press conference. Sheinbaum, who has called on Washington to recognise the role of migrants in its economy, has worked to strengthen Mexico's consular service in the U.S. to protect Mexicans deported or detained, including those being held at the "Alligator Alcatraz" detention centre in the U.S. state of Florida, according to Rutilio Escandon Cadenas, the Mexican general consul in Miami. From Jan 20 to Aug 1, more than 75,900 Mexicans were repatriated from the U.S., according to the Mexican government.

Portugal 'deeply concerned' over Israel's Gaza takeover plan, calls for immediate ceasefire



Lisbon, Aug 8 (IANS): Portuguese government on Friday voiced its deep concern over Israel's decision to "take over Gaza", urging the suspension of the plan and immediate implementation of a ceasefire.

"The Portuguese government is deeply concerned about the new plan by the Israeli government to take over Gaza. The decision undermines efforts to achieve a ceasefire and worsens the humanitarian tragedy in the Gaza Strip," the Portuguese Ministry of Foreign Affairs said in a statement published on the social media platform X.

The ministry called for the suspension of the plan, the release of hostages, and the urgent entry of humanitarian aid into Gaza, Xinhua News Agency reported.Israel's Security Cabinet has approved a plan to take over Gaza City, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office said in

Russia warns Bosnia's unity at risk atter court bans Serb leader

New York, August 7 (UNI): Russia has warned Bosnia Herzegovina's existence as a united state is at risk after a court ruling banned the president of the country's Serb-majority entity from political office for defying the international peace envoy.Bosnia's election commission removed Republika Srpska President Milorad Dodik from office after an appeals court upheld his one-year prison sentence and a six-year ban from politics for refusing to implement decisions issued the UN High Representative in BiH, Christian Schmidt — an appointment Moscow and Beijing have contested at the United Nations.

Russian Deputy Permanent Representative to the UN Dmitry Polyanskiy told reporters that Dodik's prosecution "threatens the stability of Bosnia and Herzegovina," adding that Moscow had raised the issue at a UN Security Council meeting earlier in the day.

Dodik, a longtime separatist leader, said on Wednesday he would propose a referendum on whether to accept the Electoral Central Commission's decision to revoke his mandate and call an early presidential election.

Meanwhile, UN Human Rights Chief Volker Turk has called on Israel government to halt the plan for a complete military takeover of Gaza Strip.

In a statement, Turk stated, "The Israeli Government's plan for a complete military takeover of the occupied Gaza strip must be immediately halted. It runs contrary to the ruling of the International Court of Justice that Israel must bring its occupation to an end as soon as possible, to the realisation of the agreed two-State solution and to the right of Palestinians to selfdetermination."

"On all evidence to date, this further escalation will result in more massive forced displacement, more killing, more unbearable suffering, senseless destruction and atrocity crimes," he added.

He stated that the war in Gaza "must end now" and people of Israel and Palestine must be allowed

to live side by side in peace. He called for the release of hostages and flow of humanitarian aid into Gaza Strip.He stated, "Instead of intensifying this war, the Israeli Government should put all its efforts into saving the lives of Gaza's civilians by allowing the full, unfettered flow humanitarian aid. The hostages immediately unconditionally released by Palestinian armed groups. Palestinians arbitrarily detained by Israel must also be immediately and unconditionally released."

At least 99 starved to death in Gaza in 2025: **WHO**

Gaza, Aug 8 (UNI): At least 99 people died of starvation in the Gaza Strip in 2025, including 29 children, with the actual figures expected to be much higher, Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, directorgeneral of the World Health Organization,

said on Thursday. "So far, this year, 99 people have died from malnutrition, including 29 children under five. These reported numbers are likely underestimates," he told a closed-door briefing in Geneva.

On July 23, the WHO reported a sharp rise in malnutritionrelated deaths in Gaza. Acute malnutrition affects over 10% of the population, while more than 20% of pregnant and breastfeeding women tested suffer from often severe forms of malnutrition, Tedros said. He warned that the hunger crisis was worsening due to restrictions on aid access to Gaza.

On Monday, Gaza authorities said that Israel permitted only 674 aid trucks to enter the Gaza Strip since July 27, meeting just 14% of the enclave's needs.

To adequately address the basic requirements for food, fuel, and medicines, at least 600 trucks should be allowed into Gaza daily, they estimated.

3 more 9/11 victims identified, nearly 24 years after terror attacks

New York, Aug 8 (UNI) Almost 24 years after the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, three more victims who perished in the tragedy have finally been identified.

In a news release

shared with PEOPLE on Thursday, Aug 7, the New York City Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) announced Ryan Fitzgerald of Floral Park, N.Y., Barbara Keating of Palm Springs, California, and an adult woman, whose name is being withheld at the request of her family, as the 1651st, 1652nd and 1653rd persons identified.

Their identifications were made possible by advanced DNA analysis of remains recovered from the attack, along with family outreach, said the OCME.

The OCME added that Fitzgerald's identification was confirmed through DNA testing of remains initially recovered in 2002, while the identifications of Keating and the unidentified woman were based on remains first retrieved in 2001.

According to his obituary, as reported by CW affiliate WPIX, Fitzgerald had recently begun working in the foreign currency exchange desk at Fiduciary Trust before his death. As the oldest of three children, Fitzgerald had also just started living on his own in Manhattan, per the

New York City Mayor Eric Adams issued a press statement following the announcement of the three latest identifications, stating "The pain of losing a loved one in the September 11th terror attacks echoes across the decades, but with these three new identifications, we take a step forward in comforting the family members still aching from that day...

We hope the families receiving answers from the Office of Chief Medical Examiner can take solace in the city's tireless dedication to this mission."

Heavy rain emergency

warning issued for southwestern Japanese city Tokyo, Aug 8 (UNI):

Japan's weather agency issued a heavy rain emergency warning on Friday morning for the city of Kirishima in the southwestern prefecture of Kagoshima, calling for the highest level of caution against landslides and flooding in low-lying areas and overflowing rivers.

The highest-level warning on the country's five-tier disaster alert system, the first of the year, came after Kirishima logged record rainfall, according to the Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA).A part of Kirishima registered 107.5 mm of rain in the hour to 3 a.m. local time on Friday, the heaviest on record at the location. The 12-hour total reached over 480 mm, about 1.8 times the city's August average. Torrential rain is expected to continue in the Kyushu region, including Kagoshima, through Sunday, the JMA said.

The amount of rain in the 24 hours to Saturday morning is expected to be 200 mm in southern Kyushu, and 120 mm in

northern Kyushu, it added. Weather officials warned people to remain on alert as dangerous conditions may already exist in affected areas.



As you start seeing your child having mood swings and getting irritated for no rhyme or reason, it is time that you sit down and have a chat with her.

Time for some pet Etiquette

Pets are adorable but they can get equally annoying if not trained properly. We share some tips to turn your pet into a great companion:



A recent study claimed that dog owners get the same surge of emotions when looking at their pooch as mothers do with their infants. While most of the pet owners will nod in agreement, you may find a few disagreeing. "I love my pet but he's such a nuisance. He will bark his lungs out in the middle of the night, chew on everything he gets his hands on and trouble my guests. I don't know what to do with him," says PR executive Aashish Sen who owns Peddle, a Pomeranian.

But you can set aside such worries. Dogs can adapt to human society. We share with you some useful tips to minimize your pet

Exercising pet is a good pet:

Your pet needs regular exercise to get rid of his excessive energy. Do not take him out just to litter, let him run, have fun. "This is the only way to release his excessive energy which if not released could make him irritable. It amounts to building stress which will be exhibited through excessive barking and unwanted pouncing," says Delhi-based senior veterinarian, Dr James Rappai.

No loud business:

When you are feeding or talking to your pet, do not raise your voice. Make him adapt to commands but say it once and say like you mean it. It should be firm not loud. And if you keep saying it, he won't listen unless you snap at him. "Be careful about the commands and the words you use. Don't confuse them. If you use the command 'Sit' to make him sit, do not use 'Heel' instead," says Chennai based dog trainer J Rangarajan.

Attention with care:

Some pets are in a habit to bark to grab your attention. They will bark when hungry, while greeting you, wanting to play with you. Says Pet groomer Geetika Nigam, "This habit must be modified simply by not providing positive reinforcement when he is barking for no reason.

Even your pet needs toys:

If you see your pet chewing furniture or your favourite shoes, don't snap at him. Instead give him alternatives to chew on like pet friendly toys. Spread them all over the floor and if he still goes for your shoes, give him a chewy. Says Delhi-based dog trainer Raju Sinha, "If he still goes, then direct him to a chewy. In a way, your pet is trying to teach you to be more careful with treasured items.'

Don't hit your pet when you are angry with him. The next time you get angry, first tell him firmly that he's incorrect, ignore him, and nudge him off if he comes to you. This will disorient him and he will know that the behaviour is not acceptable. "Remember, you should never resort to hitting your pet," adds J Rangarajan.

Eating habits: Never feed him while you are eating. This might be taken as a cue

that he can take food from your plate. Make him a social pet:

Don't restrict his exposure just to family else he will get really uncomfortable in front of your guests or might behave awkwardly. And remember never ask your friend if you can get your pet along to a get together or party. If they want him to come, they will say it.

Here are some ways how you can initiate a conversation about periods with your daughter.

Start the chat early

Menstruation is a part of growing up and there is absolutely no harm if you start the talk early, in small portions. It is quite a scary experience for a child to discover one fine day that she is bleeding. Says child counsellor, Ronita Chatterji, "The poor thing may not even know where the blood is coming from. She might think that she is terribly sick and that she is going to die. So, it is important that you begin the chat as soon as you see some changes in your daughter's body like pubic hair and breast development. She might even ask questions about these slight changes. When you are answering such questions you can discuss periods as

Prepare yourself first

It is important that you prepare yourself first when you start the conversation. Talk about your own experience and be prepared to answer all questions. You might require to go surf the net to study the female reproductive system. Says psychologist, Seema Hingorrani, "Mental preparation for parents is very important when they sit down for a chat with their kids. Make them feel that it is absolutely normal and maintain eye contact while talking about it." Since having periods means the onset of sexual maturity, it is important that you inform your daughter about sex and how to be careful. There are a lot of questions that might come to a child's mind: How much it hurts? How often it happens? Will she be able to play outside with her friends? Clear all doubts that are playing in your daughter's mind. Hold your daughter, since you don't want her to feel that it is something that she should be ashamed of.

Avoid bombarding her with too much information

Do not give too much information that the child gets confused. In fact, the best time to start is when there is a sanitary napkin ad playing on television. Don't give a long lecture about periods in one sitting. Start with small talk, which is easy for your daughter to absorb. Tell her that these are little changes in the body which every girl undergoes, as she gradually becomes a woman. Find out from your daughter's teachers if they are covering anything about the reproductive system in their school. If they are, it gets easier for you as the mother to explain the topic as you know that your daughter has some information about it. Don't forget to have an age-appropriate discussion with your daughter.

Inform her about basic hygiene

It is important that you teach your child how to use a pad during menstruation and how often she needs to change it. Parents should tell the child about washing her hands thoroughly and to keep her private parts clean so that there is no infection. Teach her the right disposal method.



New Delhi, Aug 8 (UNI) : The Badminton World Federation (BWF) today announced the draw for the BWF World Junior Championships 2025 -Suhandinata Cup (Mixed Team Event), to be held at the National Centre of Excellence, Amingaon, Guwahati, from October 6 to 11.Second-seeded India will compete in Group H alongside Hong Kong China, Nepal, and Ghana.

This prestigious global junior team event returns to India for the first time since 2008 and will feature 37 teams from across the world. The tournament format will see the winner from each group advance to the quarter-finals.

Top seeds Thailand are drawn in Group A with Denmark, Slovenia, and Cook Islands. Defending champions Indonesia are placed in Group C with Türkiye, Romania, and the Netherlands, while 14-time champions China will face Japan, Singapore, Brazil, and Bhutan in Group E.

This year a new relay format will be tested in the competition. In the new format there will be best of three sets, where a team

reaching 45 points in a relay format wins a set. A set will have each of men's singles, women's singles, men's doubles, women's doubles and mixed doubles matches with the first match ending after one team reaching nine points and the next match will start. Earlier, the relay format consisted of a single set with a race to 110points in 10 matches.

For the Indian team, medal winners from the Badminton Asia Junior Championships 2025 will gain direct entry, while the remaining spots will be decided through a selection

trial from 9th to 13th August 2025 at the same venue. Players eligible for the

It was also a debut performance for the German pair at the event, adding a new milestone to their decorated career. France's Charles-Guillaume Schmitt and Elena Salikhova took silver with 194.00 points, followed by Spain's Guillem Pascual Iniesta and Diandra Illes in third on 188.46.

Du and Yan scored 186.96, missing the podium by 1.5 points after five dances - samba, cha cha cha, rumba, paso doble and

jive. Balan, 34, and Moshenska, 35, four-time world champions from 2021 to 2024, began their partnership in 2015 in Pforzheim, Germany, and quickly rose to the top of

They captured German, European and World Latin titles within six weeks in 2021 and have remained among the most successful couples in international Latin dance. Balan attributed their success to "consistency" under
