#### **Tiger enters** Gondia city, later rescued

Gondia, Oct 12 (UNI) A male tiger that wandered Maharashtra's Gondia city was safely rescued after an intense five-hour operation, forest officials said today. The tiger was first spotted by locals near the Ring Road area, which houses key administrative offices, including those of the district collector and superintendent of police.

Upon receiving the alert, a forest department team rushed to the site last night.Police were also deployed to control the large crowd that had gathered to witness the incident.According to officials, the rescue team tranquilised the tiger after several hours of effort. The animal was later shifted to the Wildlife Training and Research Centre in Nagpur for examination care. Sources said the same tiger was earlier rescued on June 20 from Anjora village in Amgaon tehsil of the district.

#### **Leopard drags** Schoolgirl into field in Maharashtra's Sangamner, rescued by relative

Ahilyanagar, Oct 12 (UNI) A leopard suddenly attacked a ninth-grade student on her way to school in Digras village, Sangamner taluka in Maharashtra, dragging her into a cotton field before her maternal uncle intervened. The incident occurred on Saturday morning. The student, Pragati alias Jyoti, daughter of farmer Sakharam Shriram, studies in class IX at Sahakara Maharshi Bhausaheb Thorat Vidyalaya in the village. As she was leaving for school, a leopard lurking in a cotton field suddenly pounced and dragged her toward the field.At the same time, Pragati's maternal uncle, Devram Khemnar, was returning from school after dropping off his son. Witnessing the attack, he rushed to the field on his bike and, by blowing the horn and shouting, managed to scare the leopard away. Pragati sustained a neck injury is currently undergoing treatment at Kute Hospital in Sangamner. The uncle is being widely praised for his courage. The incident has created fear in the village, with residents demanding that the local administration and forest department take preventive measures against increasing leopard attacks.



# **Cooperation Minister Patil apologises** for farmer loan waiver remarks

Latur, Oct 12 (UNI): Maharashtra Cooperation Minister Babasaheb Patil has issued a formal apology for his recent remarks concerning farmers and loan waivers, expressing regret if his comments caused distress to agricultural communities.

The apology follows widespread political backlash over Patil's statement at a bank inauguration event in Chopda, Jalgaon district, where he had suggested that farmers had developed an "addiction" to loan

waivers and questioned the long-term sustainability community. of such relief schemes.

Clarifying his remarks, Patil reaffirmed his commitment to strengthening rural economies through selfreliant models such as dairy cooperatives like Gokul Dudh Sangh in western Maharashtra, which provide steady income sources for farmers.



# When misplaced outrage overshadows real oppression

The Afghan Embassy did a surprising course correction after facing backlash for the exclusion of women journalists from media interaction in New Delhi.

It could have been because of the pressure from the hosting country, or it may have been to show a 'humane face' before the international glare in the wake of facing aggression from Pakistan. The change enforced by the evolving situation, however, does not change the truth -- the Taliban do not like the very concept of freedom for women.

This is a country where women are routinely discriminated against -- even during moments of catastrophe. Against this grim backdrop, barring women journalists from a diplomatic event on October 11 in New Delhi seemed like a small, predictable extension of a much larger and cruel ideology.

Yet, in India, the controversy took an unexpected turn. Rather than directing outrage at the Taliban's misogynistic policies, several politicians used the incident as a weapon to attack the Modi government, turning a human rights issue into a political skirmish.

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra was among the first to demand answers from Prime Minister Narendra Modi. She accused the government of allowing such discrimination to occur on Indian soil and failing to defend women's rights.

Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra went further, asking why the press conference was permitted at all. "You talk about Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao, about women's empowerment and dignity," she said, "and yet you roll out a red carpet for a delegation that disrespects women."

The criticism was fierce. The Ministry of External Affairs clarified that the Afghan Consul General's office in Mumbai handled the invitations independently. The embassy premises are in Afghan territory and therefore not under Indian jurisdiction.

Despite this clarification, the controversy refused to die down. Opposition leaders continued to attack the Centre, missing the deeper issue -- the ongoing and systematic oppression of women under Taliban rule.

Since seizing power in 2021, the Taliban have stripped Afghan women of nearly every basic right. Girls over the age of 12 are forbidden from attending school, women are barred from most employment, and even those working in humanitarian organisations have been ordered to stay home.

Books by female authors have been removed from university libraries. Women are not allowed to visit parks, gyms, or even public baths. They cannot travel long distances without a male guardian. Every aspect of daily life has been reduced to a rigid set of restrictions justified through the Taliban's narrow interpretation of Sharia law.

The results are catastrophic, particularly in times of disaster. When devastating earthquakes struck Afghanistan's Herat province in 2023, or the recent one in September, killing thousands, women bore a disproportionate share of the suffering.

In deeply conservative areas, rescue efforts stalled because men hesitated to offer help to women in times of distress. Aid workers reported that food and medical supplies were distributed first to men, while women went without. Some women who lost their families were prevented from living alone in tents because that violated Taliban rules. The same regime that claims to "protect women's honour" leaves them to die unattended in rubble.

International organisations have also sounded repeated alarms over the restrictions on Afghan women and girls. The United Nations Human Rights Council, in its July 2024 report, described the situation as "grave, worsening, widespread, and systematic oppression".

It urged the Taliban to reverse policies that exclude females from education, employment, and public life. But the Taliban remain unmoved, insisting they are upholding "Islamic values" and "Afghan culture".

Ironically, while global outrage focuses on the Taliban's brutality, in India, the press conference incident has become a tool for domestic political point-scoring. Instead of rallying together to condemn the Taliban's medieval mindset, many opposition leaders have chosen to criticise the Modi government.

Rahul Gandhi, the Lok Sabha Leader of Opposition, took a direct aim at the Prime Minister, writing on his X handle, "When you allow the exclusion of women journalists from a public forum, you are telling every woman in India that you are too weak to stand up for them. In our country, women have the right to equal participation in every space. Your silence in the face of such discrimination exposes the emptiness of your slogans on Nari Shakti."

He made it look as if the Indian government did this -- a diversion that risks diluting the moral message. The debate, Rahul Gandhi and his supporters have tried to shift from who is committing the injustice to who is to blame for hosting them!

The Opposition leaders in India may have found a critical point in the October 11 no-women-allowed presser in the Afghan Embassy, but the answer has also been given in the Sunday event, which sources said happened with a nudge from the MEA.

# Jairam Ramesh warns of 'systematic erosion' of RTI Act, says govt undermining transparency

New Delhi, Oct 12 (UNI) Congress leader Jairam Ramesh today issued a stark warning about the "gradual erosion" of India's landmark Right to Information (RTI) Act, accusing the current government of systematically weakening this critical pillar of transparency and accountability

Speaking at a press conference marking 20 years since the RTI Act's full implementation, Ramesh recalled the transformative impact of the law on governance and citizen empowerment.. "Exactly 20 years ago today, the historic RTI Act came into full effect, ushering in a new era of citizen empowerment and transparency," he said.

Placing the RTI in the broader reform wave of 2005–2013, Ramesh highlighted that the period saw the enactment of several rights-based legislations on rural employment, forest rights, education, food security, and land acquisition — all aimed at empowering marginalized citizens and deepening democracy.

However, Ramesh lamented, "Since May 2014, we have witnessed a deliberate and continuous effort to dilute these rights." He singled out the July 2019 amendments to the RTI Act, which were "forcibly pushed through Parliament." "I opposed these changes in the Rajya Sabha and challenged them in the Supreme Court, but the petition has languished for six years," he added.

Further setbacks, he noted, came with the Digital Personal Data Protection Act passed in August 2023. "I warned the concerned minister in March 2025 that this law would render the RTI Act even more irrelevant," Ramesh said.

The current state of the Central Information Commission (CIC) also drew sharp criticism. "The CIC is functioning with only two commissioners, with nine posts—including that of the Chief Information Commissioner—lying vacant for over 15 months," said Ramesh. "For the Modi government, RTI now stands for 'Readiness To Intimidate'—a readiness to intimidate those demanding transparency."

# **Kuldeep's spin** gives India edge: Doeschate

New Delhi, Oct 12 (UNI) : India assistant coach Ten today Doeschate highlighted the decisive role of Kuldeep Yadav's mystery spin in India's ongoing second Test against West Indies, describing it as a key factor in challenging conditions on a deteriorating pitch.

Speaking at stumps, Doeschate said the slowing wicket required bowlers to adapt constantly. "You have to fire the ball in, but then there's less chance of spinning. It was quite a tricky afternoon," he noted, praising West Indies batsmen like John Campbell skillful their counterplay. Despite this, he emphasised that Kuldeep's variations kept the opposition under pressure.

"The difference with Kuldeep is he's not the easiest to pick. That element of danger makes him effective compared to other spinners," Doeschate said. He explained that Kuldeep's accuracy, ability to spin both ways, and use of small but critical margins helped India take key wickets, even on an unresponsive surface.

Doeschate

highlighted that India's strategy balances matchwinning goals with player development. Tactical decisions-such bowling rotations, limited use of pace bowlers, and adjusting the batting order, were made to maximise the effectiveness of key players like Kuldeep, while giving opportunities to young talents.He praised the team culture, noting Shubman's leadership, the contributions experienced players like Ravindra Jadeja, and the focus on playing for the team first. "Hopefully we come in tomorrow and put a clinical performance in on the back of a very tough session," Doeschate said. underscoring the team's intent to capitalize on Kuldeep's impact in the final stages.

# Raiza, Bhavtegh miss finals as USA win Skeet golds

New Delhi, Oct 12 (UNI): Bhavtegh Singh Gill and Olympian Raiza Dhillon missed out on finals qualification as the skeet events at the ISSF World Championship Shotgun 2025 concluded at the Malakasa Shooting Range in Athens, Greece, on Sunday (Oct 12). The day belonged to the United States, as World No.1 Samantha Simonton and four-time Olympic champion Vincent Hancock claimed the women's and men's skeet world championship respectively, leading to a remarkable clean sweep of all four skeet gold medals for Team USA, with the men and women team golds also going to them.

In the women's skeet final, Simonton shot 57 to take gold ahead of Mexico's Gabriela Rodriguez, who secured silver with 54 hits, while Sweden's Victoria Larsson clinched bronze with 44.

Earlier in qualification, Simonton had topped the field with 122 hits, followed by Rodriguez on 120 (8 in shootoff) and Larsson, who claimed the sixth and final qualification spot with 119 (3), edging out veteran Kimberly Rhode and Slovakia's Vanesa Hockova.

Among the Indians, Raiza Dhillon finished 16th with a total of 116 hits (23, 22, 24, 22, 25), while Parinaaz Dhaliwal (21, 23, 22, 21, 23) and Ganemat Sekhon (21, 22, 24, 21, 22) finished 44th and 47th respectively with 110 hits each.

In the women's team event, the American trio of Samantha Simonton, Kimberly Rhode, and Dania Jo Vizzi (15th individually) clinched gold with a combined score of 358. Cyprus (349) took silver, Slovakia (348) secured bronze, and India finished eighth with 336.

# **Jayden Seales fined** for ICC Code of **Conduct breach** during India Test

New Delhi, Oct 12 (UNI): West Indies fast bowler Jayden Seales has been fined 25 percent of his match fee for a Level 1 breach of the ICC Code of Conduct during the second Test against India.

According to the International Cricket Council (ICC), Seales was found guilty of breaching Article 2.9 of the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel, which relates to "throwing a ball (or any other item of cricket equipment) at or near a player in an inappropriate and/or dangerous manner during an International Match."

In addition to the fine, one demerit point has been added to Seales' disciplinary record, taking his total demerit points to two in a 24-month period. The previous demerit point for Seales dates back to a Test match against Bangladesh in December 2024.

The incident occurred on Friday, the opening day of the second Test against India, during the 29th over India's first innings, when Seales, after fielding the ball on his follow, threw it at batter Yashaswi Jaiswal, hitting him on

Seales contested the sanction proposed by Andy Pycroft of the Emirates ICC Elite Panel of Match Referees, so a formal hearing was required, the website noted.

The Windies pacer contested that he threw the ball while attempting a run out. The Match Referee, referring to replay clips showing the incident from different angles, concluded that the throw was unnecessary and inappropriate, hitting the batter on the pads when he was within the crease.

The charge was levelled by on-field umpires Richard Illingworth and Paul Reiffel, third umpire Alex Wharf and fourth umpire K.N. Ananthapadmanabhan.

As per ICC regulations, Level 1 breaches carry a minimum penalty of an official reprimand, a maximum penalty of 50 percent of a player's match fee, and one or two demerit points.

West Indies are currently trailing 1-0 in the two-match ICC World Test Championship series in India, following the loss by an innings and 140 runs in Ahmedabad in the first Test, ICC highlighted.

# Campbell, Hope stage brave fightback in Delhi
